The \$75,000 PPP money received in Feb. 2021 shows up as a loan not as income so that is why the negative net income is high but our bank balance remains relatively healthy.</li> <li>9. A final transfer of \$10,465 of PPP money was made in July from savings to checking. No other PPP money is available.</li> </ul>
